

# ROOSEVELT ON BROADWAY

## New York City Field Trip

Spring Break, April 13-20, 2020



**WHAT:** A week in NYC for Broadway, performance and tech workshops, tours and more! We will all be seeing Harry Potter and the Cursed Child, Moulin Rouge, Six: The Musical, and Hadestown! In addition to time for museums and Central Park we'll have workshops and tours from Broadway professionals!

**WHERE:** We will be staying at the Hampton Inn in Times Square. Please note that students will be sleeping four to a room and the rooms are TINY but fun!

**WHO:** 24 actors and technicians currently in theatre classes!

**HOW:** We are still booking some shows and experiences. The trip will cost approximately **\$2,000-\$2,300 + food.**

- Limited booster scholarship assistance is available and will be distributed according to financial need. You may apply for assistance now at [www.rhstheatre.net/forms](http://www.rhstheatre.net/forms). On the attached Commitment to Attend Form, please check the box indicating you have applied for assistance. You do not need to submit the \$100 deposit if you have checked this box. After Boosters have reviewed all scholarship requests, they will contact the applicants with the amount they will be able to award. The applicant will need to fundraise or pay the balance, although there is some flexibility to extend payment installments up to two months after the trip (June, 2020).
- In addition, students may **choose** to fundraise their way to pay for some or all of the trip. Please check the box on the Commitment to Attend Form to indicate whether you are planning to fundraise and how much of the estimated cost you will be fundraising.
  - Our optional fundraiser will be selling boxes of Sees Candy peanut brittle (\$7.00 retail, \$3.50 profit) or individual Sees chocolate bars (\$2.50 retail, \$1.25 profit).
  - For example, to fundraise one \$400 monthly trip payment, you would need to sell 115 5oz boxes of Sees Peanut Brittle **or** 320 chocolate bars. This could be accomplished in several afternoons outside of a grocery story (think Girl Scouts) who agrees to have you.



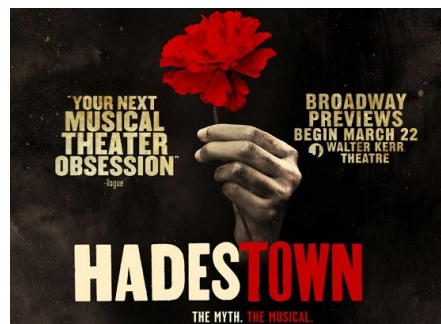
**WHEN:** We will begin taking Commitment to Attend forms & deposits on **Monday, November 18 at 7:30am in person** in the Theatre Office.

- No Commitment to Attend forms will be received prior to this time.
- Spots will be filled first come first serve by those who submit complete forms signed by a parent and include:
  - A \$100 deposit (cash or check made out to Roosevelt High School) OR
  - The “Applying for Booster Scholarship” box checked on the application form
- Payments will be received monthly: cash, check, or SchoolPay:
  - Beginning Monday, November 18: \$100 Deposit or check Booster Scholarship box and apply
  - Wednesday, December 4: \$400
  - Wednesday, January 8: \$400
  - Wednesday, February 5: \$400
  - Wednesday, March 4: \$400
  - Wednesday, April 1: Remaining balance (\$300-\$600, TBD)



**CHAPERONES & SAFETY:** Students will be assigned to teacher/staff chaperones at a 6:1 ratio (or less). There will be a mandatory logistics and safety meeting with the chaperones, students, and parents on Tuesday, April 7 at 6:30pm.
